PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER STATUS
State law now allows any voter who so requests to be a Permanent Absentee Voter. If you check the Permanent Absentee Voter box on the Application for Absent Voter's Ballot, an absentee ballot will automatically be sent to you for future elections. Failure to vote in two consecutive statewide general elections will cancel your Permanent Absent Voter Status and you will need to reapply.

Application must be received in the County Clerk's office no later than February 27, 2007.
