Date 2010	Activity
Jan 1* - Feb 25 E-158 to E-103	Petitions for signatures in-lieu of filing fee for local offices available. <i>*Jan 1<sup>st</sup> is a holiday, activity begins next regular business day, Monday Jan 4<sup>th</sup>.</i>
Feb 15 - Mar 12 E-113 to E-88	Nomination Papers/Declaration of Candidacy filing period.
Mar 12 E-88	Last Day for Local Measures to qualify for the ballot.
Mar 13 – Mar 17 E-87 – E-83	Extension of filing deadline if incumbent fails to file for his/her office. Candidates <b>other than incumbents</b> can file during this time period.
Mar 18 at 11 am E-82	Randomized alpha draw to determine the order in which candidate names for each office will be printed on the ballot.
Apr 12 – May 25 E-57 to E-14	Write-In Candidates filing period.
Apr 9 E-60	First day to mail ballots to military/overseas voters.
Apr 29 to May 18 E-40 to E-21	Legal time period for mailing county sample ballot booklets.
May 10 to June 1 E-29 to E-7	Vote-by-Mail ballots can be requested and mailed during this time period.
Week of May 10	County Clerk=s Office to mail ballots to mail ballot precinct voters and permanent vote-by-mail voters.
May 24 E-15	Last day to register to vote for the primary election.
June 2 - Jun 8 E-6 to E-0	Vote-by-Mail ballots available in the County Clerk=s Office only.
Week of June 1	Opening and counting of voted mail ballots will begin in the County Clerk=s Office. (Approximate Dates)
Jun 8 E-0	Election Day. Polls are open from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m. Vote-by-Mail ballots must be turned into the Clerk=s Office or a polling place no later than 8 p.m.
Jun 9 E+1	Counting of vote-by-mail ballots received at the polls on election day.
Jun 10 E+2	Official Canvass begins, including counting provisional ballots.
July 6 E+28	Last day to certify results.
