This is a Department Head position with general responsibility for the administration of County Behavioral Health and Alcohol and Drug programs and functions. These programs include: Adult & Children Outpatient services, Senior Peer Counseling, Chemical Dependency Treatment and after hours Crisis. The department has a budget of approximately \$20 million and 100 employees. The department has offices located in Yreka and Mt Shasta. This position serves at the will of the Board of Supervisors.

Required: Based on Section 620, Chapter 3 of Title 9, State Administrative Code, of the following would apply:

1. A physician licensed in CA with 3 yrs of graduate training in psychiatry supplemented by an additional 2 yrs of training/practice limited to the field of psychiatry, 1 yr of which shall have administration experience.
2. A psychologist licensed in CA & possess a doctorate degree in psychology. With 3 yrs of clinical psychology experience, with 2 yrs of administrative experience.
3. A clinical social worker, marriage, family therapist, or registered nurse with a master's degree or higher in respective field & licensed under either the CA Business & Professional Code or the CA Board of Registered Nursing, have practice and clinical experience, 5 yrs of which have been administrative experience.

Special Requirements: Possession of a current and appropriate driver's license.

Employment Benefits

Insurances The County offers dental, vision, and a comprehensive health plan.

Disability Insurance: Paid by the County as follows: Long Term up to 60% of salary after 90 days of disability, Short Term up to 50% of salary from day 6 to day 90 of disability.

Life Insurance: Coverage amount for this position is two times the gross annual salary.

Deferred Compensation A 457 deferred compensation account is available to all employees. A \$200 contribution is made monthly for this position by the County.

Public Employees Retirement System (PERS): 2% at 55. County pays employee portion to PERS. Single highest year salary calculation for retirement purposes.

Leaves: Vacation with pay begins at ten days annually for full-time positions available immediately upon date of hire. Vacation increases to 15 days after five years of employment; 20 days after ten years of employment, 60 hrs of Admin leave per calendar year with option to be taken off or paid, sick leave at 12 days per year, holiday leave at 12 days per year plus 3 floating days.
