

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Bids open @ 10:00 am, May 23rd, 2017

General work description:

Guys Gulch (Schedule A) (Road): Work includes the reconstruction of approx. 0.35 miles of roadway by making major changes in the alignment. Clearing and grubbing is to be performed, minor cuts are to be made and fills constructed. Existing surfacing is to be pulverized, material from the existing roadway is to be excavated and utilized in the reconstruction. Aggregate base will be placed on the newly constructed grade and overlaid with hot mix asphalt. Existing culverts are to be removed, new culverts placed, and drainage ditches constructed. Driveway connections are to be constructed and paved, portions of existing fences will be removed, and new fences constructed. Work will include other items or details not mentioned above as required by the plans and specifications.

Guys Gulch Bridge (Schedule B): Work includes the construction of a cast in place reinforced concrete slab bridge (approx. 35ft. 10in. long by 33ft. 4in. wide) on concrete abutments and driven precast concrete piles. The existing reinforced concrete triple box culvert will be removed, clearing and grubbing is to be performed, portions of existing fences are to be removed and new fence constructed, approach roadways are to be constructed, and other items or details not mentioned above as required by the plans and specifications.

Schulmeyer Creek Bridge (Schedule C): Work includes the construction of a cast in place, reinforced concrete slab bridge (approx. 35ft. 10in. long by 33ft. 4in. wide), on concrete abutments and driven precast concrete piles. The existing reinforced concrete triple box culvert will be removed, detour constructed, approach roadway widened, rock slope protection placed, and other items or details not mentioned above as required by the plans and specifications.

The Contractor must have either a Class A license or a combination of Class C licenses which constitutes a majority of the work.

This contract is subject to California Public Contract Code § 9204

Bids must be on a unit price basis.

Complete the work within **100 working days**.

The estimated cost of the project is **\$1.7 million**.

No prebid meeting is scheduled for this project.

The Department will receive bids until 10:00 a.m. on the bid open date at Siskiyou County, Department of Public Works 1312 Fairlane Road, Yreka CA 96097. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The Department will open and publicly read the bids at the above location immediately after the specified closing time.

Submit your bid with bidder's security equal to at least 10 percent of the bid.

Prevailing wages are required on this Contract. The Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations determines the general prevailing wage rates.
