

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 1:30p.m., in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, Siskiyou County Courthouse, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, California on the following item:

MENNE-BASTISTICH AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE AMENDMENT AND WILLIAMSON ACT CONTRACT RESCISSION AND REENTRY (APA-16-01)

Proposed amendments to two agricultural preserves and rescission of two Williamson Act contracts with subsequent reentry in order to effect a proposed boundary line adjustment (BLA-16-07) between agricultural properties. The project site is located at 11518 Oro Fino Road and 12120 Rosedale Road approximately 2.75 miles west of the Town of Fort Jones, on APNs 014-130-370, 390, 480, & 550 in Sections 29, 30, 31, 32 & 33, T44N, R9W; and APNs 024-040-380, 024-050-100, 110, 120, 130, 140, 150, 160, & 170, in Sections 4, 5, & 6, T43N, R9W, MDB&M.


It is anticipated that the proposed agricultural preserve and Williamson Act contract amendments will be determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15317, Open Space Contracts or Easements. A categorical exemption implies that a project will not result in any significant adverse environmental effects. The Board of Supervisors will consider the appropriateness of said environmental recommendation based on the record of evidence before them. If substantial evidence is presented demonstrating a more appropriate environmental determination than the one being recommended, the Board of Supervisors may require and/or approve an alternative environmental determination pursuant to the requirements of CEQA.

All publications are on file in the Planning Division office for public review, and all interested persons are invited to attend the meeting and be heard on any agenda item. In addition, a staff report will be available at the Planning Division office three working days prior to the Board of Supervisors' meeting. All interested persons are invited to be present and be heard thereon or present comments in writing to the Board of Supervisors, 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097. All items presented to the Board of Supervisors during a public hearing, including but not limited to, letters, email, petitions, photos, or maps, become a permanent part of the record and must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board. It is advised that the presenter bring 7 copies of anything presented to the Board and that the presenter create copies in advance for their own records.

If you challenge the agricultural preserve and/or Williamson Act contract amendments in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Clerk of the Board at, or prior to, the public hearing.
