With the June 5, 2018 Primary Election only six weeks away, Siskiyou County Clerk Colleen Setzer encourages all eligible voters to participate in this important election. The deadline to register to vote is May 21<sup>st</sup>, and to be eligible to vote, a person must be at least 18 years of age on or before June 5<sup>th</sup>, a United States citizen, a resident of California, not imprisoned or on parole for the conviction of a felony and not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court. The quickest way to register to vote is online at [www.registertovote.ca.gov](http://www.registertovote.ca.gov). Additionally, voter registration cards are available at the County Clerk's Office, libraries and post offices throughout the county. To insure timely delivery of election information, a voter should register to vote when they move, change their name or change their political party affiliation.

Ms. Setzer is pleased to announce that mailings are on schedule for this election. Voters should expect to see their sample ballots in their mailboxes during the week of April 30<sup>th</sup> and ballots during the week of May 7<sup>th</sup>.

The ballot for the June 5<sup>th</sup> election is lengthy, including 27 candidates for governor and 32 candidates for United States Senator. The ballot itself is two pages, with contests printed on both sides of each page. Ms. Setzer cautions voters who opt to return their ballot by mail to be sure to include sufficient postage on the envelope.

The County Clerk's Office continues to recruit poll workers for the June 5<sup>th</sup> election, as there are several positions to be filled throughout the county. Poll workers receive a stipend for their work and are required to attend a training class. For further information and to sign up, contact Shelley Gray at the County Clerk's Office at 842-8086.
