UPDATE: Happy Camp Armed Robbery Suspect Identified

On Wednesday, June 14, 2017, at about 10:22 a.m., the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) received a call of an armed robbery that occurred at the Happy Camp branch of the Scott Valley Bank. SCSO Deputies responded to the scene but the suspect had already fled the scene. A preliminary investigation revealed a male suspect entered the bank and claimed he had a gun and demanded money. An undisclosed amount of cash was taken and the suspect fled the area on foot. Bank employees did not see a firearm.

Following an investigation by the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit, the suspect has been identified as Jade Charleton Yandell of Cave Junction. Jade and Cedar Yandell were both arrested in a cooperative effort with Grants Pass Public Safety Department and Medford Police Department on June 28th in relation to a recent bank robbery that occurred in Grants Pass.
