

Library-to-School Program

The Siskiyou County Library has started a new pilot program called Library-to-School. We are testing it out at two local schools: Little Shasta Elementary and Delphic Elementary. We want to extend library services to local, outlying schools in order to lower barriers and increase access to our public library collection and online services.

Library-to-School program

- Sign up students for library cards
- Show how to access their online library account
- Demonstrate placing a hold online
- Demonstrate Library's online services (Mango Languages, Tutor.com, etc.)
- Deliver holds to the school and pick up returns
- Monthly visit for Story time

Advantages for students

- Receive library items at their school
- Return items to their school
- No overdue fees

Overall advantages

- Reach students who cannot make it to the library
- Enhance the school library collection
- Serve diverse needs of a school's students
- Compliment the school's current programming with the County Office of Education

Over time, we anticipate offering these services to other interested schools.
