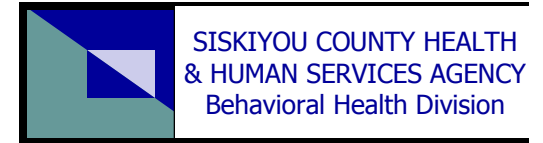

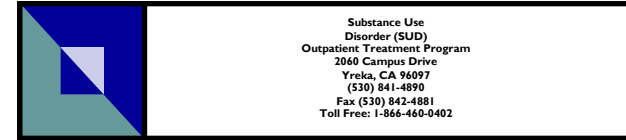

Adolescent treatment is a voluntary process; however, the SUD treatment system often serves youth who “volunteer” for treatment as a choice to avoid more severe consequences (school expulsion, juvenile detention, felony conviction, placement in group home, or a parental consequence). Such treatment can be successful if youth are assessed and matched with the appropriate level of service, and the program is successful in motivating the youth to change. The SUD Department is committed to serving the youth and families of Siskiyou County.
