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A RESOLUTION OF THE SISKIYOU COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE WOOD SMOKE REDUCTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of California legislature committed \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2021-2022 to continue implementing the Wood Smoke Reduction Program, replacing uncertified, inefficient wood burning devices with cleaner burning, higher efficiency devices (Program); and

WHEREAS, the District shall receive funding from CAPCOA in the amount of \$219,060.00 to implement the Program which shall be completed by June 30, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Siskiyou County Air Pollution Control Board hereby:

- 2) Authorizes expenditures which include salaries, benefits, public outreach, education and administrative expenses, associated with and in furtherance of the Program.
- 3) Authorizes a budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 increasing revenues and expenditures for the Program in the amount of \$219,060.00.
