

Notice of Public Hearing

For Adoption of the Groundwater Sustainability Plan the Butte Valley Subbasin

The Directors of the Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District will hold a public hearing on July 9, 2024 in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, at 9:00a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, to consider adoption of the Butte Valley Subbasin's Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP). The GSP was developed pursuant to the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (CA Water Code, Section 10720 et seq.) for the Butte Valley Subbasin (Groundwater Subbasin Number: 1-003).

The public may attend by zoom/teleconference or in person. All interested persons are invited to be present and be heard thereon or present comments in writing to the Directors of the Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, 311 Fourth Street, Room 201, Yreka, CA 96097 or to the following email: wendy@sisqvotes.org. All items presented to the Directors of the Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District during a public hearing, including but not limited to, letters, e-mail, petitions, photos, or maps, become a permanent part of the record and must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board. It is advised that the presenter bring 7 copies of anything presented to the District Board and that the presenter create copies in advance for their own records.

All public records related to an open session item on the agenda, which are not exempt from disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act, that are distributed to a majority of the legislative body will be available for public inspection at 311 Fourth Street, Room 201, Yreka CA 96097 at the same time that the public records are distributed or made available to **a majority of** the members of the legislative body. All supporting documentation is available for public review in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, located in the Siskiyou County Clerk's Office, 311 Fourth Street, Room 201, Yreka, CA 96097, during regular business hours, 9:00a.m. – 12:00p.m. and 1:00p.m. - 4:00p.m., Monday through Friday.

If you challenge this issue in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Directors of the Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District at, or prior to, the public hearing.
