Situation Summary:	At 4:00 p.m. today, CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 5 assumed command of the Mill and Mountain Fires. The fire is actively burning in steep broken terrain, with short duration crown runs and spotting. Weather continues to be hot and dry with poor overnight relative humidity recoveries. A number of resources continued to arrive throughout the day. Personnel engaged in structure defense and strengthening control lines.
