On October 17, 2016, former Secretary of the Interior Sally Jewell submitted a letter (2016 letter) related to the referenced Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) projects and applications filed in September 2016 pursuant to the 2016 Amended Klamath Hydroelectric Settlement Agreement (KHSA). The KHSA, however, did not require submission of the 2016 letter from Secretary Jewell.

Accordingly, I hereby withdraw the 2016 letter as unnecessary to the current proceedings before FERC. The Department of the Interior will continue to engage with relevant parties and stakeholders on these and related Klamath Basin issues.
