At the Tuesday 3/20/18 Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District meeting at 1:30pm, the University of California, Davis will be providing an update regarding their groundwater work in the Scott Valley groundwater basin, which has included developing water budgets, models, and planning. UC Davis has worked closely with water users, Cooperative Extension, the County and others to produce this work, and UC Davis will provide an outline for future potential work related to the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act. This outline will also include potential work in the Shasta and Butte Valley groundwater basins, and what opportunities UC Davis can offer to the Groundwater Sustainability Agency.
