- Q: In the same Section (4), the last bullet asks for firm experience with similar projects, and then in Section 7 (Page 5), the RFP asks for Relevant Experience. Confirming you want this in both sections.
- A: Yes, please include in both sections to ensure a complete response.
- Q: In Section 7) Relevant Experience (Page 5), the RFP requests a minimum of three "business" references. Please confirm what business reference means? For example, banking, or insurance?
- A: Please include three references of other municipalities/organizations that you have provided a similar work product.
- Q: Still under Section 7, is there a minimum number of references required for PMS Municipalities?
- A: Please see the response to the last question.
- Q: Same question for the last bullet in Section 7. Is there a minimum number of references required for Municipal Government projects?
